Christmas is a time when lots of young people receive devices that are able to access social media such as tablets, smartphones, games consoles and laptops.

If these devices are new to young people they can often not secure the settings sufficiently and this can unfortunately put them at risk.

There are programmes and applications they can access such as Netflix and Amazon where they can watch programmes that are often not age appropriate and not suitable for them to watch. Games consoles are sometimes played by young people where games are a classified 18 certificate.

www.thinkuknow.co.uk is a brilliant website that can help and support you as a family stay safe online. There also many 'think you know videos' you can watch on YouTube that will show you how to manage settings and secure your child's online world so any risk is reduced and where possible completely eliminated.

We have also attached several documents that can support you in monitoring the online behaviour of children and young people which we hope you find useful.
