## Dear Parents and Carers,

The Government last night updated their advice regarding Coronavirus. Some advice remains the same. Currently schools should continue to stay open and students should continue to attend school. Students should not attend school if they are unwell with a new, continuous cough or a high temperature. Advice regarding self-isolation has, however, changed:

• if you live with others and you or one of them have symptoms of coronavirus, then all household members must stay at home and not leave the house for 14 days. We are currently assessing our contingency plans for partial or full closure if or when this is needed. Partial closure would mean closing to certain year groups only. Any decision to close will be governed by various considerations such as the need to prioritise Y11 in advance of their GCSEs and vulnerable groups.
