



Dear Parents/Carers of Year 7

I hope that you are keeping well and have enjoyed your Summer Break. I would like to once again thank you for all your support with regards to our Virtual Transition and I hope that your son/daughter is looking forward to joining us next week.

At the end of last term, you will hopefully remember that we took the decision to offer, all new Year 7 pupils the opportunity to visit the school on the Training Day of Monday 6th September. We are very much looking forward to this day and giving the pupils the opportunity to meet their Heads of Year, have a tour of the school, meet the rest of their form, their form tutor and key staff at the Lower Site. Pupils will also be able to collect their school tie on this day.

All Year 7 pupils will need to arrive at school by 8.40 and will need to enter the school building along the red path at the top of Hall Drive. This will lead pupils to the brown gates where they will then be directed to the Lower playground. For those students who are still unsure as to where this is, this can be seen on the induction [Tour of The School](#)'. We would actively encourage you to allow your son/daughter to walk up Hall Drive and we politely ask that those parents/carers who intend to drop off their son/daughter, that this is done without coming up Hall Drive to avoid any congestion. Members of staff will be visible on Hall Drive to support pupils as they make their way up Hall Drive.

On the day, pupils will need to wear their full school uniform. I would like to remind you that whilst we would strongly encourage all pupils to attend on Monday 6th September, if you are unable to make this day due to prior arrangements, your son/daughter will not miss the opportunity to interact with their form. Pupils will have a morning with their forms on the Tuesday and will therefore not be disadvantaged if they are unable to attend the day before.
