Dear Parent / Guardian, Re: Yr 7 "LION KING EXPERIENCE SHOW"

Your son / daughter is performing in the "Lion King Experience show" on either **Tuesday 18th (APPLETON) or Wednesday 19th October (STOCKTON) at Upper School**. The performance is an opportunity to show you the work that has been going on in Art, Dance, Drama and Music in your child's first six weeks at Bridgewater. The performance starts at **7pm** and *usually* lasts an hour or *just* over.

Arrival & dismissal for the school day	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Normal times but at Upper School thank you. Pupils will be registered at Upper School. Pupils can bring a book to read during the day when not rehearsing but NOT electronic games, thank you.
Rehearsal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All day at Upper School / rehearse in school uniform (girls to have PE shorts or leggings under skirt). Lunch – "do what you normally do" – if you purchase lunch, do so at Upper School. If you bring packed lunch, do so as usual. Water – a very good idea to have a bottle of water for rehearsal day.
Open Rehearsal in Upper School Hall. Parents please arrive approx. 2pm. You will be met and taken to the Hall.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We have a full run through between approx 2.10 and 3.10. This is a very good representation of the evening show. If you wish to come to this, please e-mail k.barratt@bridgewaterhigh.com, quoting pupil name and Form (please specify if the <u>pupil surname is different</u> from yours). If this means you will NOT be attending in the evening, please also e-mail j.wolfenden@bridgewaterhigh.com so I can re-allocate your evening seat. Pupils DO NOT stay in school between the rehearsal and the show.
Evening for pupils	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pupils wear Dance Kit to perform in at the evening show, please. Pupils need to be at school for 6pm. PLEASE DROP PUPILS OFF rather than wait from 6pm
Evening for parents Tickets & arrival for the evening show	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We have an absolute limit of 200 seats per night (Fire Regulations) so CANNOT allocate two tickets to every child and, we are sorry but, siblings <u>cannot</u> sit on a parent's knee. As a way of avoiding the issue of lost tickets, we are NOT issuing actual tickets this year. Instead, you will be asked for your child's name and Form when you arrive for the show. There is no need to e-mail to ask for an evening ticket; you have been allocated <u>ONE</u>. We will only be able to admit <u>one person</u> for each child. Respectfully, we have to say that we can still only allocate one ticket per child in cases where parents / carers are separated or divorced. After allocating parent seats / Form Teacher seats etc we will have a small number of "PLUS ONE" tickets that will be allocated on a random basis <u>during rehearsal</u>. Please do not e-mail requesting a "PLUS ONE" ticket. Doors open 6.45 p.m.
